I don't know anything about that scope, but take a look at completed Ebay items #110013394896(Nikon), #260015604523(Zeiss) and #170012032016(Olympus).

They're all well within your budget, almost certainly much better quality, and worth about the same when you want to trade up (or you can upgrade piecemeal).

If you're willing to shop around patiently, second hand equipment offers a lot more bang for the buck for hobby use (IMO).

I want a decent quality binocular biological scope for under \$400 if possible. I plan to use it just for hobby purposes. I've done a fair amount of research and shopping on the net and have come up with several scopes that seem to fit my needs and budget. But having no recent experience with scopes, I could really use some help and advice from the group.
